AIMS AND ASPIRATION:

The K.V.G. I.T.C. in its programme aims at high Industrial orientation to the youth of the vast surrounding rural areas as well as to the nation as a whole. The students in the I.T.C. will have ample opportunities of Industrial exposure and training during the period of their training.

ESTABLISHMENT:

The Institute is recognised by the Govt. of Karnataka and affiliated to the National Council for vocational training New Delhi. All the rules and regulations in respect of eligibility for admission, curriculum terms, attendance, fees payable, for registrations Examination etc., are prescribed by the Directorate of Employment and training Bangalore.

BUILDING:

A Permanent building is constructed, with all facilities of laboratory and library. A well equipped workshop is completed and a spacious administrative block is under construction. The campus of the Institute is on a site measuring about five acres.

INTRODUCTION

Kurunji Venkatramana Gowda Industrial Training Centre is established in Bhagamandala, Madikeri Taluk of Kodagu District under the auspicious of the Academy of Liberal Education (Regd.) Sullia. The Academy is running K.V.G. Polytechnic, Nehru Memorial College (First Grade), K.V.G. College of Engineering, K.V.G. Institute of Nursing, K.V.G. Dental College, K.V.G. English Medium High School and K.V.G. Law College, K.V.G. LIC and K.V.G. Medical College in Sullia. The Academy extends its deep sense of gratitude to Sri Ramakrishna Hegde, Former Chief Minister of Karnataka, Sri D. Manjunatha, Former Minister for Labour and Sri B.A. Jivijaya, Former Minister for state for forests in Karnataka for their munificence guidance help and co-operation to our educational institutions. The management is very grateful to the Govt. of Karnataka in this regard, Under the dynamic and the ablest stewardship of its founder president Dr. Kurunji Venkatramana Gowda, it is felt that the Industrial Training Centre would care to its best flowerence.

LOCATION:

The campus of the Industrial Training Centre is known for its natural scenic beauty besides everflowing Cauvery rolls with silent majesty. Towering beautiful hills and forests and flush greenary of the surrounding Coffee and Cardamum estates provide a scintillating back-ground to the campus of the centre. It is an ideal place for academic pursuit removed from the buzz and din of the city life. Bhagamandala is a holy pilgrim centre situated in North Kodagu. There is adequate facilities of transport and communication to this centre. The campus of the centre is at a distance of 40 km. from Madikeri and 35 km. from Karike, a place of Kerala border.

HOSTELS:

The Institute has two hostels for men and women which are situated in the same premises. It provides facilities for outstationed students on actual cost sharing basis 140 student may be accommodated in the new Hostel.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF HOSTEL:

- 1) Every student seeking admission to hostel should be accompanied by parents without fail.
- 2) Every student should be have in the hostel with utmost sense of discipline
- 3) Unauthorised student or outsiders should not be entertained without the permission of the Warden
- 4) Every student must follow the rules laid down by the warden from time to time.
- 5) Every student shall pay the hostel dues well in time and no defaulting is permitted in this regard
- 6) No student shall damage the hostel property in which case he or she will be liable to pay to the penalty and stand summarily expulsion from the hostel.
- 7) No student shall cultivate or practice bad habits like smoking, drinking, playing cards and ragging in which case the student condemed will be liable to summarily expulsion from the hostel.

MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION:

The Institution is giving instruction to various courses through English Medium only. In view of the week background of the students in the area. Intensive instructions and classes are conducted to students.

LIBRARY:

This Institution has a very good library with good collection of books on various subjects taught in the institution which is sufficient to meet the requirements of the students.

ELIGIBILITY ADMISSION:

An applicant should be passed certificate in S.S.L.C. He/She should be between 16 to 40 years.

ADMISSION:

A copy of the application form is enclosed herein, the last date for the admission of the completed application form at the office of the Industrial Training Centre is 15th August application received at this office after the last date will not be considered for admission. On scrutiny of applications received before the last date prescribed eligible applicants will be considered to be called for interview will, however be restricted to one and half times of the actual number of seats available for admission so as to accommodate in the vacancies arising due to failure to appear for interview or subsequent dropouts. In case a candidate is selected at the interview an admission letter will be given to him on the same day giving particulars of the branch allotted fees payable etc. Successful candidate will have to get themselves admitted immediately there after on payment of fees. The right of allotment of branch to each student rest with the Selection Committee.

The prescribed fees should be paid on or before the prescribed dates failing which heavy fines will be collected from the prescribed dates, after which the name will be struck off from the Attendance Rools of Institute.

EXAMINATION:

A part from the final examination to be held in July every year (Periodical tests both in theory and practicals will be conducted by the Institute a intervals during the Training Course) Those who secure on aggregate of 40% of marks in Ththeory and 60% of marks in practicals with 80% of attendance will be awarded a basic certificate by the Institute.

The terminal examination will be conducted as Scheduled below:

I Term	:	Last week of November
II Term	:	Last weel of February
III Term	:	Last week of May
IV Term	:	Last week of July

The Progress Report of the above examination will be sent to the Parents that should be returned by the student duly signed by the parents.

INSTITUTE DISCIPLINE

- 1) For day to day behaviour every student of the I.T.C. is responsible to the Principal
- 2) Every student is expected to come to the classes neatly and properly dressed
- 3) While attedning the workshop practice each and every candidate must wear uniform dresses as per the direction of the Principal
- 4) Due respect to the staff of the I.T.C. should be shown by the studnets at all times.
- 5) Smoking is strictly prohibited on the college premises.
- 6) Students are not expected to consume alcohol on the college premises.

- 7) Silence must be strictly observed not only in the class rooms but also in the Library, Reading Room, Workshops, Corridors and Canteen.
- 8) Late comming, irregular attendance and indifference to studies are viewed very seriously and the students are liable to be expelled from the Institute for these reasons.
- 9) Loitering in the corridors disturbing the classes, earns penalty and punishment by the Principal.
- 10) No student is allowed to attend any class other than his her own except by the permission of the teacher conderned.
- 11) Studnets are strictly prohibited from disfiguring walls, tables, desks and benches
- 12) Any deliberate damage done to the property of Institute shall be severly dealt with and the student responsible to be penalised and expelled from the Institute.
- 13) Any act which is likely to against the interest of the management of the Institutes, or the student community in general or the maintenance of the discipline and good tradition of the Institute shall be viewed seriously and the students indulging in such activities shall be summerily expelled from the Institute.
- 14) Students must be bound by all the rules of the Institute framed from time to time to keep up the name and dignity of the Institute.
- 15) Parents or Guardians of the students are advised to keep vigil over their students/ wards and keep up healthy relations with the Institute.
- 16) Student should not abstain from the classes without the permission of the Principal.
- 17) Students should submit leave applications to the Principal in case they have genuine and valid reasons for their absence.
- 18) No students shall enter the classes or leave the class without the permission of the teacher.
- 19) Students with vehicles will take care that their comming and goings will not disturb classes.
- 20) Those students who abstain from the class continuously 3 periods without the permission of Principal will not be permitted to attend the classes unless they meet Principal with their parent/ guardian.
